

ISOLATION RATES At a Glance



COVID-19 DDA Services

Temporary changes, effective March 13, 2020, and Revised March 14, 2022

Availability of Isolation Rates

- The following service rates may be increased for supporting people that have positive determination for the COVID-19 virus, and therefore are required to be isolated. It may also be used when a person: is symptomatic; awaiting testing results; tested negative and still symptomatic; isolate from roommates that are waiting for test results; or just recently discharged from a hospital, and therefore are required to be isolated.
 - Community Living Group Home
 - Nursing Services (e.g., Nurse Health Case Management & Delegation Services, Nurse Consultation, and Nurse Health Case Management)
 - Personal Supports
 - Shared Living
 - Supported Living
- Isolation Rates can be requested and may be billed up to 21 days unless otherwise authorized by the DDA while the person is in isolation (Ends on June 30, 2022)

Isolation Rate

- Rates are increased by up to 50% (EndsonJune 30, 2022)
- Increased rate for the Community Living-Group Home service includes add-ons

Isolation Rates Documentation and Billing

- DDA will share detailed billing and documentation guidance
- Providers must maintain and submit documentation of direct service delivery supports, and the positive determination result to support the increase rate upon request by the DDA
