



Medicaid Check-In — Redeterminations

- Look out for communication from the Maryland Department of Human Services and respond within the required timeframe.
- People with Redetermination Due Dates scheduled for August, September, and October 2023:
 - If a redetermination application was submitted it will be processed.
 - If a redetermination application was not submitted, the redetermination was moved to November 2023.

LTSS Transition

- 52% "all-in" as of October 1, 2023
- 63% "all-in" by January 2024
- WMRO will be 100% transitioned as of October 1, 2023!
- Early Adopter Group (EAG) Technical Assistance can be requested here





Person-Centered Plan (PCP) Enhancements

 PCP Enhancement Committee has been meeting regularly since May 2023

 Committee consists of various stakeholders from across the state including:

- Self-advocates
- Family members
- Coordinator of Community Services
- Provider agencies
- Community partners
- Working to finalize PCP template recommendations and move towards reviewing system revisions in the coming months



Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) – Respite Reminder

Under the DDA's **Traditional Service Model**, effective **October 1**, **2023**:

- Respite Care 15-minute services will become a service billed through EVV.
- Respite Care daily services and camp are not required for EVV.

Health and Incident Reporting Updates

Seasonal viruses are upon us!

- Everyone 6 months and older should get vaccinated every season, especially people at higher risk.
- Updated COVID-19 vaccines from Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna will be available this month.
- Remember COVID-19 is a reportable disease, as are other communicable diseases defined by the Maryland Department of Health.
- If you are over 60 or pregnant, ask your doctor about a new RSV vaccine.






Health and Incident Reporting Updates

For reporting COVID-19 per the Policy on Reportable Incidents and Investigations, please use the following guidelines:

- Two or more cases of positive COVID-19 in people or staff members within 10 days in the same setting.
- Report incident reports for people in PCIS2.
- Notify your DDA Regional Office Quality Enhancement team via email for staff reports.

Audited Financial Statements

- Required for Providers billing in LTSSMaryland.
- Needed for FY2022 and FY2023, and annually moving forward.
 - FY2022 Audited Financial Statements are due September 30th!
 - FY2023 are due no later than (NLT) December 31, 2023, and annually following the close of the fiscal year NLT December 31 of the respective year.
